Darrick Whittaker of 4990 Southpointe Pkwy, Monroe, MI 48161 contacted the Drain Commissioner on behalf of Ms. Antwih and advised that the retention pond has the capacity to hold the standing water if a drainage ditch or drain tile is installed. Supervisor Barron is looking into it with Building Inspector Mike Black. Public comments ended at 7:34 p.m.
